

London Wall Place City of London, London

Within the footprint of this archaeologically rich site lie the remains of St Alphage Church, a section of Roman Wall which originally encircled Londinium and St Alphage Garden.

We were appointed by a main landscape contractor to provide detailed construction level information for a number of specific external works elements.

The information provided enabled the landscape contractor to have the developed detail design signed off by the client's team and have the fabricators produce their shop drawings for checking, prior to manufacture.

We were initially commissioned to prepare three detailed "mock up" packages of information. One each for the clamber terrace (to the remains of St Alphage Church), concrete seat/ paving junctions and the water feature. This was to enable our client's client to test various finishes and junctions and enabled them to decide which was most desirable for the final finishes.

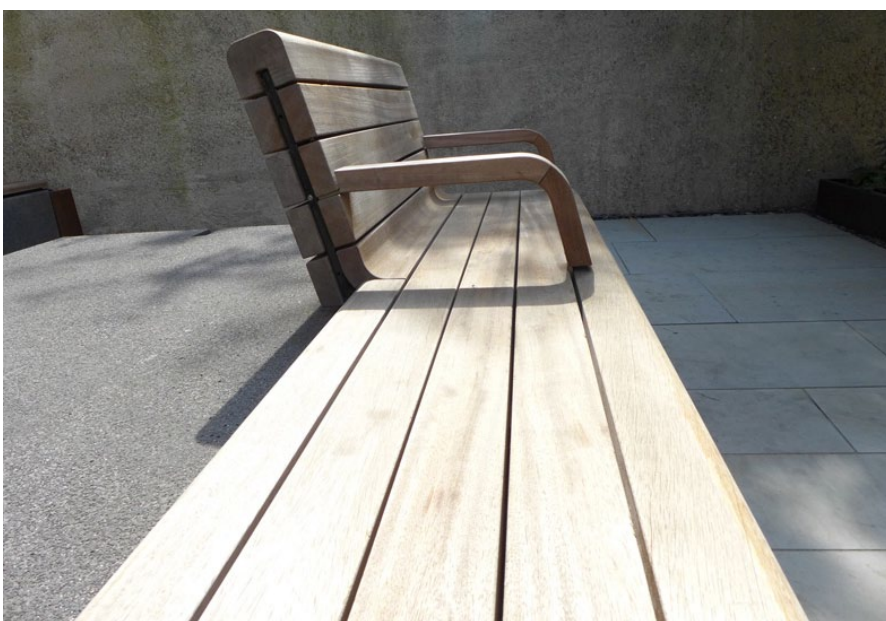
We then developed the detailed design, produced full schedules and full setting out information for the weathered steel edgings (corten steel) for the entire site. This was followed by the detailed design of all bespoke public seating and finally the detailed design of the water feature bridge.
