Turkey Street Station, London

The redesign of the public realm around Turkey Street Rail Station, carried out in conjunction with building improvements. The design created a pedestrian focused space which connects the station forecourt to the park opposite. The proposals introduced new cycleways linking existing cycle routes and included traffic calming measures.



Monmouth Road Green, London

Angel Gardens is a 1.5ha new public park situated adjacent to Angel Road train station. The project challenges included the remediation of contaminated land and a site watercourse. Key features included substantial areas of planting, communal gardens, footpaths, a small orchard and playful granite cubes to mark the Enfield/ Broxbourne boundary.

An artist was commissioned to develop playful artwork to complement these features.
